Our Aboriginal Health Worker provides support to Patients experiencing Alcohol or Substance use issues. Through pharmacotherapy treatments, referrals and advocacy support to detoxification withdrawal clinics and rehabilitation programs, One on One support, and psychologist counselling.

Aims of the program

To provide alcohol & other drugs services to the Communities of the Macleay Valley in a clinically and allied health-based service approach through educational promotion and treatment therapies.





Target group

Our service is available to registered patients of the Medical Service who have undertaken an Aboriginal Health Assessment (715) by a General Practitioner at Durri Aboriginal Corporation Medical Services within the past 12 months.

If you or family members are experiencing issues with substance use, please make an appointment with one of our General Practitioners (GP's) or our AOD workers for a referral.
